#### A BRIEF PROFILE OF MOUNT TIYI COLLEGE

Mount Tiyi College was established in 1974 through the initiative of some of the prominent citizens of Wokha district who had envisioned in providing opportunity for higher learning to the people in the district, especially to the less privileged section of the society. The college initially provided pre-university course under North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) and upgraded to Degree Level in 1979. It was taken over by the State Government in 1987 and is affiliated to the Nagaland University since 1990. It is a co-educational institution in Arts stream only. The institution is AAA (Academic Administrative Audit) assessed by the Directorate of Higher Education Nagaland, with B+ grading, and is NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) assessed with Grade C score.

The College with its motto "Surge et Luce"- Rise and Shine, endeavours to inspire and empower the learners with knowledge, skills and prepare them to face challenges ahead of them in life.

The College is committed to provide holistic education, uphold moral values and inculcate discipline in the students with the objective to mould them into responsible citizens.

#### **Admission Procedure**

- Students shall view the Prospectus online and follow the instructions contained therein for admission and all other purposes. Hard copy may be obtained as and when actual classes resume.
- 2. Admission to various semesters shall be done online and only in extreme cases will it be done offline.
- 3. Candidates seeking admission to B.A. 1st Semester shall apply in a prescribed admission form during the period 08/06/2020 to 20/06/2020.
- 4. Admission form duly filled in must be attached with the following:
  - (a) Photocopy of HSLC Admit Card, Mark Sheet and Pass Certificate
  - (b) Photocopy of HSSLC Admit Card, Mark Sheet and Pass Certificate
  - (c) Photocopy of NBSE Registration Card
  - (d) Two (2) Nos. of recent Passport size Photo and One (1) Stamp size photo
  - (e) Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate are required from candidates coming from different Board/ University other than NBSE
  - (f) Original Documents must be produced at the time of admission.

#### SELECTION FOR ADMISSION

The Selection for admission shall be made on Merit Basis or any other criteria laid down by the Admission Committee.

- 4. Any student willing to change his/her subject combination should apply to the Principal within 30 days from the date of admission. Students will not be allowed to change their subjects after expiry of the above specified period
- 5. Student can also opt for Certificate Course in Floriculture under RUSA Programme
- 6. The college offers Certificate course in Computer Applications which is purely optional.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Mount Tiyi College has laid down the following rules and regulations and expects each student to abide by them diligently.

- 1. The college expects the students to be disciplined, well-behaved and show due respect to the authority, teachers and staff.

- 8. Strict action amounting to up to expulsion will be taken on students found indulging in unfair means during examinations.
- 9. Students must face all the internal assessment and clear all the three tests- Assignment, Test and Presentation or any other internal assessment conducted by the concerned departments; failing to do so, the student will not be allowed to sit for the external examination.
- 10. Students must keep their classrooms and college building neat and clean. Any damage to college property through act of anger or violence shall be subjected to realization of fines from the concerned student.
- 11. Students must be regular in class and must attain at least 75% attendance in all subjects during the semester.
- 12. Students must carry their Identity Card with them at all times and the ID card must be renewed at the beginning of each subsequent semester.

A student may apply for Post-Matric Scholarship from the Government of Nagaland through the college authority. Meritorious students are entitled to apply for Nagaland/ National Merit Scholarship.

#### **AWARDS**

The College has instituted the **Late Mhondamo Kithan Memorial Award for Academic Excellence.** It is sponsored by the family of Lt. Mhondamo Kithan, the first Lotha graduate and the first Education Minister in Nagaland. The award carries a cash prize of Rs 10,000/- and a citation.

This award will be given to the most outstanding student of Mount Tiyi College, securing first division, in the University final examination.

#### **IGNOU STUDY CENTRE**

The IGNOU study centre attached to the college is located within the campus and offers Under Graduate, Post Graduate, Diploma and Certificate programmes under Open & Distance Learning mode. Tiyi College.

#### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

- 1. Literary activities are organized under the theme Creativity Splash. It encourages students to explore and exhibit their talents.
- 2. National Service Scheme (NSS) organizes social work in the college from time to time and participate in creating awareness under Swaach Bharat.
- 3. Red Ribbon Club organizes Awareness programmes on HIV Aids, Blood donation and Blood grouping.
- 4. Women Cell initiated in 2015 organizes workshops relating to gender issues, women's health and empowerment, and creativity skills etc.
- 5. Career Guidance and Counseling Cell conducts programmes for job opportunities, employment, skill enhancement etc.
- 6. Games and Sports activities are conducted during the College Week and encourage students to participate in various sports events. The college also participates in the Olympiad each year.
- 7. The College has an Ethics Committee which provides spiritual guidance and counseling to the students.
